## **Boise Track Selective Block**

During this four week block, second year resident will choose to develop a research, quality improvement or patient safety project. We aim for resident to formulate a project concept and established mentorship in Boise or Seattle prior to the Selective month. Four weeks prior to the beginning the Selective month, residents will submit a project proposal to Dr. Wilper for comment, review and approval. During this month, residents will have protected time to carry out the project. Residents less interested in pursuing a novel project will be permitted to spend an additional month at one of the [Community Based Training](#) sites, with the caveat that this additional month will require that the resident formulate a question regarding some aspect of the practice characteristics of the site. Residents will present their research/CBT queries to the program and medical service at the end of the academic year.
